This Week's Program

Rotary Club of Livermore Grants in Partnership with LVEF

Sally Esser, representing LVEF, and MaryAnn Rozsa, representing Rotary. This is the first of three sets of awards. Twenty-two applications received; nineteen funded. For the year, Rotary is contributing \$16K; LVEF is contributing \$10K. For this set, Rotary is donating \$7K and LVEF is matching \$2575 of that.

The awards fall into several categories:

1. Grants to teachers in the Livermore school district for use in public schools. These grants have been matched by LVEF
2. Grants to private religious schools.
3. Grants to community organizations helping those in need.
