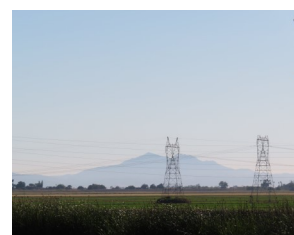

A potential new member, Paul Bagen, with New York Life met with Kendra and Wayne, and has filled out his membership application and had his first visit this week!

A prospective new member, a professor with UOP will be joining the Soleimani's at the fundraiser.

Tony Yaden, who spoke to us about Parents by Choice, met with Wayne and is interested in joining.

Evan introduced PDG Judy Lovett as our speaker. She will replace Bob Melrose as District Grants Chair this coming term. Judy spoke about the Rotary Foundation and announced 5 new Paul Harris recipients. To be awarded at a later date, the recipients are Jill Faso Antonini, Lauren Nguyen, Don Williams, Karen Rea +5 and Andy Chesley +6.

The Rotary Foundation was founded in 1917, by Arch Klumph. Its purpose, "it seems eminently proper that we should accept endowments for the purpose of doing good in the world". Coming out from WWI, this was a great idea.

The Rotary Foundation has prospered since and receives a 4 star rating from Charity Navigator for 13 years in a row. It is the #1 rated charity in the world for the past several years.

Every dollar donated is invested for three years. After three years, 50% of the District's donations come back to the district. (District designated funds or DDF)

District Designated Funds are used for: Club Grants, Global Grants, Scholarships and Vocational Training Teams.

All grants must fall within one of the seven areas of focus: Preventing Disease, clean water, education and literacy, growing local economies. Maternal and infant health, and peace and environment.

Clubs are allocated a portion of the district DDF based on their giving during the prior 2 1/2 years. This can be used for community and international projects under \$30,000.00. The district matches the club's contribution toward a project up to the club's allocated DDF.

Global Grants—at least one-half of a district's DDF must be allotted to global grants. The Rotary Foundation will match the District's DDF toward a global grant. 80% match starting July 1, 2021.

North Stockton's total giving is \$589,870.00. We have 49 Paul Harris Fellows. We have 4 in the Paul Harris Society and 5 Major Donors. Locally our club per person this year is \$221.25. The goal was \$175.00!!!!



PDG Judy Lovett spoke to us.

To see where your giving stands, go to Rotary.org. You can see your giving history. Judy has offered to assist anyone interested in checking. Incredible Foundation success. Polio Plus! The continent of Africa was declared Polio free last summer. Two countries are left. Afghanistan and Pakistan. The Foundation is using its experience with polio plus to help spread the covid vaccines all over the world.

Your generosity keeps the Foundation going. Because of you, people have clean water, better health, a more peaceful world, a cleaner environment, healthier babies and moms, stronger economies, and better education. You made it happen!

So, See you Saturday at Books Bands and BBQ's at 5pm. It's our first big event and we're so glad to be back together.

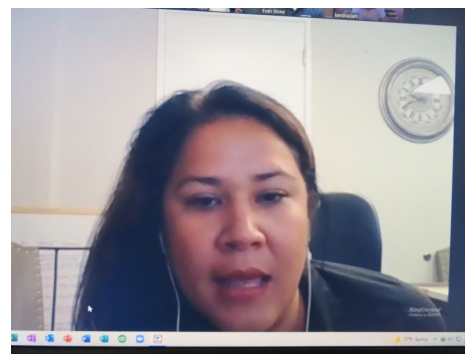

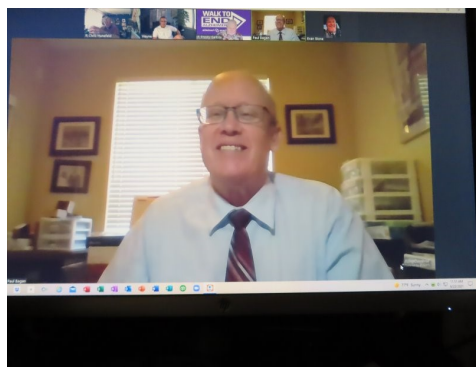

Membership Wayne is filling our membership up



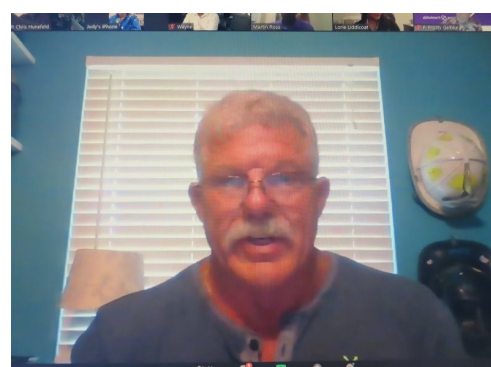
Lorie and Kendra have got our big fundraiser ready to happen!
