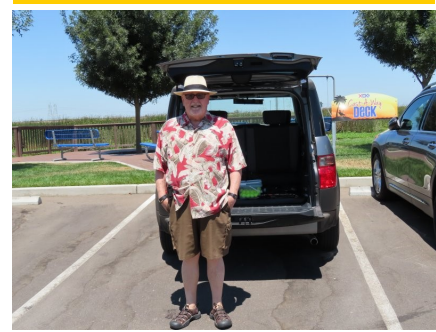


Our first Pledge, 4-way and thought Live!
