




07/27/21 - Back at Village West Yacht Club. We will be there all of August.

Evan attended a Board of Supervisors meeting with the other local Presidents and DG nominee Waqar Rizvi. They received a proclamation of superior service to the community, because that's what we do.

Andy then introduced our speaker:

Please welcome Matt Zitard who is the Water Resources Manager for the County of San Joaquin. Yes, I intend to keep inviting speakers who I can talk with about county policy and governance so you will have to get used to it. Matt has thirty years experience with water related issues in both the public and private sectors. He graduated from Colorado State University in hydrology and to demonstrate his commitment to the subject he lives out here on a boat three nights a week. Welcome Matt Zotard.

Matt explained that he has been engaged in water a groundwater resources planning, management and engineering for over 30 years. He understands structural and non structural strategies to integrate land use and water supply plans, projects and policy: and work to resolve issues of

agricultural-urban interface. His ares of expertise include groundwater and integrated regional planning, groundwater recharge/storage, reservoir operations, nitrates, flood management, seawater intrusion, wastewater recycling, water rights, water conservation surface and groundwater modeling, GIS applications in water management and on and on.

The State and County have declared a drought emergency. Not unusual for California. He pointed out that the groundwater is getting dangerously low in some areas, there are consequences to that. It needs to rain buckets. We need to pay the taxes to qualify for federal grants to renew our infrastructure concerning water at the tune of \$1

dollar from us equals \$4 from the feds. Tis money would fortify our levees, fight saltwater intrusion, and hopefully create more storage for water.

He said the tunnels are moving forward and being engineered. We know that if the tunnels are built and transfer what water we have left, we will dry up and blow away. (My words, not his).

In summation, he has an insurmountable job. Thank God he's there. Let's do what we can to support him and his work. Well, that's the meeting, see you next week.
