Dave holds a bachelors degree in Political Science and dual graduate degrees in Public Administration and Criminal Justice Administration from San Jose State University. Peninsula. Dave grew up and went to school in Santa Cruz County. Dave's mother's family came to Northern California in the 1840s.

His first call was as a youth pastor in a large church in Long Beach. Some of the members of his original youth group have re-connected with Jay and he is having a great time meeting with them via Zoom. Probably wouldn't have happened without the Covid virus, so good things sometimes come out of bad.

In 1974 Jay and his wife, Gail, and their two young children moved to Monterey where Jay had been called as Pastor of First Presbyterian Church of Monterey. He served for thirty-six years in that capacity which is a testimony to the long suffering of that congregation. But it was a happy time for Jay because he met so many wonderful and dedicated persons who had a heart for serving their community. Thanks to that spirit some good things happened. Jay and a couple of others from his church were part of the original board of Interim Inc. which is one of the most respected non-profit groups in our community. First Presbyterian Church was one of the founding churches for The Interfaith Homeless Emergency Lodging (IHELP) over twenty-five years ago, and IHELP continues to this day. Jay served as one of the first volunteer chaplains at CHOMP, and continued for twenty-six years. I guess he is prone to getting into ruts and staying there, but they are good ruts.
