Hans Uslar – City Of Monterey



Mr. Uslar began his career with the City of Monterey in 1997 as a Management Analyst and was promoted through the Plans and Public Works Department. He became Assistant Director of Plans and Public Works in 2008, and Deputy City Manager/Plans and Public Works in 2012.

He was named Assistant City Manager in 2014 and was appointed City Manager in 2018.

Mr. Uslar played a key role in the Presidio of Monterey base operations contract, known as the Monterey Model, a benchmark for public-public partnerships since its start in 1998. In the past two years Mr. Uslar has concentrated on restoring Monterey's fiscal health, matching service levels and expectation with fiscal realities, providing staff focus on affordable housing solutions as well as striking a balance between residents and visitors.

As City Manager, Mr. Uslar has been also responsible for the City's multi-levelled responses to the devastating impacts of COVID-19.

Mr. Uslar's previous experience includes serving as Project Manager at the Institute for Strategies and Studies in Waldbroel, Germany; Assistant Chief of Branch, Naval Policies and Strategies, Department of Defense, in Bonn, Germany; and Commanding Officer of the German Navy's ship "Hermelin", Kiel, Germany.

Mr. Uslar is a member of the International City Manager's Association, the Association of Defense Communities and a founding member of the California Defense Communities Alliance.

He lives in Monterey with his wife and he has a college age son who just started attending the Monterey College of Law.
