Molly Bozzo Molly Bozzo was born in Aspen, Colorado. Her parents were teachers and ranch managers down the Aspen valley in a little mining town called Carbondale. This is where Molly grew up. Her days were spent feeding cattle, hustling to school, skiing, and pestering her older brother. For high school, Molly attended both the Colorado Rocky Mountain School (in Carbondale) and Phillips Exeter Academy in Exeter, New Hampshire.

She earned a BA in English literature from Lewis & Clark College in Portland, Oregon (she attended Lewis & Clark because they gave her a full-ride scholarship for all four years). After college, she began teaching elementary school and two years later, moved to Monterey,

California to become the dean of student life and varsity soccer coach at Santa Catalina School. She went on to earn a master's degree in Education Administration and Leadership from San Jose State University, while simultaneously teaching English and history at Seaside High School. In 1999 she married Andy Bozzo, moved to Tacoma, Washington, and became the dean of students at Charles Wright Academy. In 2003 she welcomed her son Luca into the world, and in 2005 her daughter, Sofia, arrived. Less than a year later, Andy and Molly packed up and moved back down to Monterey to be near family and the ocean.
