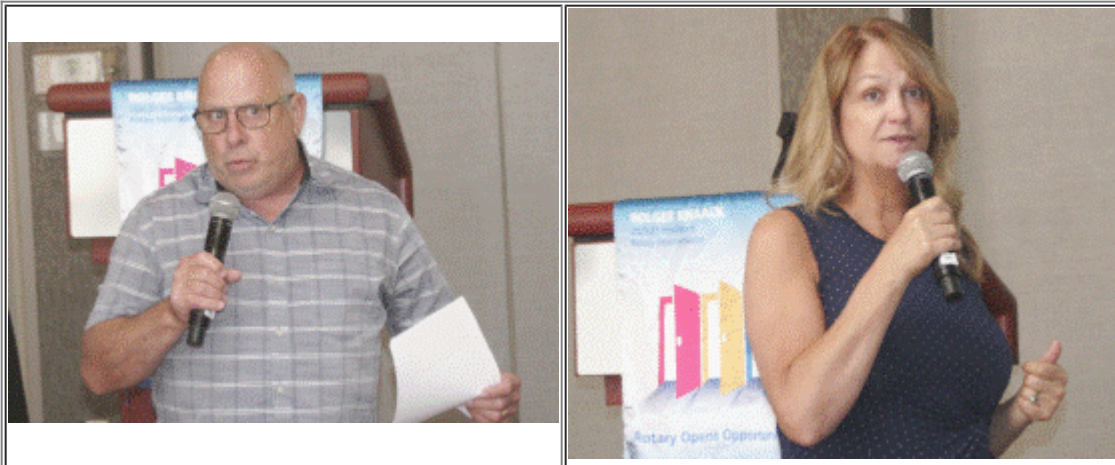
Wine Auction

and has 1400 affiliates in California alone. Other than just a home, it brings people together to build homes, communities, and hope. The vision is a world where everyone has a decent place to live. The organization provides shelter in different ways. They may build from the ground up, they may remodel a burned shell, or they may assist with repairs. The ReStore keeps reusable building materials out of landfills and sell them at 50% or less of retail. The ReStore takes donations of furniture, appliances, mattresses, and box springs in addition to building materials; they will also pick up items. Beneficiaries must contribute 500 hours of "sweat equity" and pay a mortgage that doesn't exceed a third of their income over 25 to 30 years at zero percent interest. 85% of the families stay in their homes. Having an affordable mortgage allows some families to send their children to college. In twenty years they have helped sixty families and 300 people in the Central Valley. A healthy family is a healthy community.
