Provide towels to the Victorville Rescue Mission for their Mobile Shower Unit

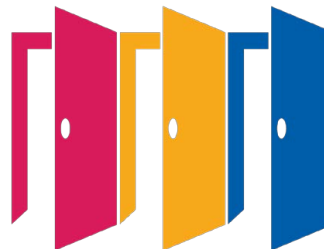
