


The Summit Services provide specialized support for clients with a dual diagnosis of developmental and behavioral challenges, aiming to teach social skills, reduce behavioral incidents, and increase abilities to work in and enjoy the local community. Apart from having many opportunities for paid or volunteer work, OPARC is also constantly looking for employers willing to participate in their workintegration programs. Often, participation can bring financial benefits and OPARC will be available to ensure adequate performance on the offered jobs. A good way to test the idea is to participate in the Paid Internship Program which reimburses employers for wages and benefits to essentially create a form of free trial employment.

When California passed the Lanterman Developmental Disabilities Services Act in 1969 that guarantees people with developmental disabilities and their families the right to services and support needed to live a more integrated and normal life, the implementation was assigned to regional centers, including the Inland and San Gabriel/Pomona Regional Centers. OPARC is one
