
GUESTS AND VISITING ROTARIANS

The LA County Fair will start next Friday, September 1st at the Fairplex in Pomona.

The Fairplex houses around 500 events annually ranging from tradeshows to quinceañeras. It operates many businesses across categories a varied as sport competitions, art, agriculture, education, and technology. Examples for such businesses include the Sheraton and Conference Center, various restaurants, The Learning Center, and an equipment rental company. It is a 501(c)5 community benefit organization that donated around \$5.5 million back to the community in 2016 via various programs and hosts frequent

community events and always welcomes volunteers and school field trips to The Farm.

The LA County Fair will continue this tradition of community service with a food drive, a school supply drive, Fair Kids field trips, a blood drive, marching band camp, and support for the American Red Cross. The Fair will offer many attractions like the Millard Sheets Art Center, the Magical World of Dragons, Wizards, and Beasts exhibit, The Igloo, the Wilderness Ridge, The Farm, the Big Red Barn, Jurassic Planet, the Garden Railroad, and The Taylor Swift Experience presented by the GRAMMY Museum.
