

PROGRAM - Senator Connie Leyva


California Senator Connie Leyva has a deep connection with and interest in this region of the state. Not only does her family have roots in Pomona, she also grew up in Chino. Senator Leyva is supporting several upcoming local community events, including the Young Men's Leadership Conference in Fontana on September 29th teaching a broad range of life and work skills including educational topics, manners, and how to tie a tie. The Community Health and Resource Fair in Ayala Park in Bloomington on October 7th will offer nutrition information, community resources, and free health, dental, and vision screenings. On October 22nd

hold an open house. The open house for her San Bernardino office will be around Christmas. Senator Leyva is also working on setting up weekly food give-away

events in Montclair starting later this year.

On a state-wide level, she has authored and supported many bills and initiatives addressing several of California's challenges, one of the biggest being affordable housing. As the Chair of the Senate Select Committee on Manufactured Home Communities, she is seeking to rehabilitate run-down mobile home parks with a \$30 million investment as well as instituting licensing requirements for mobile home park managers. To assist low-income families with being able to earn a living, she has introduced bill SB 78 which was able to secure \$50 million to fund and expand after school programs. She also introduced bills to fight different forms of sexual assault or abuse, like SB 813 which eliminates the statue of limitations on rape and certain other sexual offenses, and SB 500 that expands the legal definition of 'extortion' to include obtaining sexual favors, like sexual acts or images.
