

PROGRAM - Nora Jacob - InsideOut Art Shows

Nora Jacob visited the club to speak about UrbanMission and the InsideOut Art Shows. UrbanMission is a unique new church in Pomona, founded in 2013 as part of the United Church of Christ/Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). Their Restorative Justice Ministries brought together a group of organizations, eventually incorporated as the Pomona Valley Reentry Coalition, to assist the societal reintegration of citizens returning from prison or jail

well as providing assistance with clothing and meals. These services are becoming more and more important as new legislation speeds up release for many of the 95%

of incarcerated citizens that will eventually rejoin the community.

A frequent challenge is to find ways for inmates to explore, express, and manage their emotions, especially if they struggle with attention disorders. Their reintegration is often further hindered by the fact that the community often forgets about its inmates until they are released.

To help address these issues, UrbanMission has created the InsideOut Art Shows that allow inmates to share the often impressive art work they create in prison with the outside world. This warden-supported project provides inmates with opportunities to connect with the outside community and talk about their lives, the justice system, and art. It also gives inmates a chance to make amends with society by raising money for local organizations through the sale of their art. The program has been very well received and has seen a three-fold growth in the number of art pieces displayed in the last year. The next InsideOut Art Show will be held at the Claremont Forum Prison Library Project Bookstore in April of 2018.
