

Footsteps 2 Brilliance is offering a platform that school districts can provide to local parents to help even the playing field. The platform consists of an app that works on most Android and iOS devices as well as in most web browsers, where children can engage in thousands of different activities, including reading or creating books, listening to songs, or playing educational games. The app tracks each child's progress in the different activities and provides a web interface for parents and/or teachers to monitor their learning. To make it accessible to a broad audience, the app is usually provided to the parents free of charge and is available in English and Spanish. An internet connection is only required for initial setup of the app or for the optional downloading of new curricular material or uploading of progress reports. PUSD has signed up for this service and is providing it for free to all families living within its geographic boundaries.

Footsteps 2 Brilliance offers many opportunities for volunteers to join their mission to fight childhood illiteracy, including becoming an ambassador and helping spread the word about the service.
