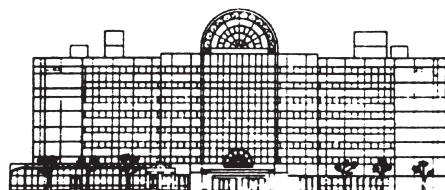

PROGRAM - William Hung - American Idol

After excelling in high school, William Hung joined UC Berkeley's civil engineering program, where he was shocked to receive the first 'D' of his life. In the middle of questioning his career choices, he saw a poster for an on-campus talent show and decided to participate by performing Ricky Martin's song "She Bangs". To his great surprise, he won first place and when American Idol came to San Francisco to audition, he decided to try his luck there as well. Since his parents did not see entertainment as a desirable career path, he had to keep his audition a secret.
From the initial 3,000 performers, he was invited back

the next day and eventually sang for Randy Jackson, Paula Abdul, and Simon Cowell. His audition was later aired on TV as an example of a miserably failed performance and went viral. Fox News pronounced him the worst singer ever and his performance was even shown in class by one of his professors. William received hundreds of requests for appearances and even an offer for a \$25,000 record deal. William decided not to hide in shame, but instead to overcome his fear of judgment and accept the offers for appearances. 'E' stands for examining your next steps, i.e. frequently making and updating your plans to move forward.
