The facility is currently servicing an area with a population of about 800,000 people and serviced over 10,000 animals last year. In 2018, so far, the Humane Society has been able to fulfill their goal of not euthanizing a single healthy or treatable animal.

To be able to meet these goals in the future and to provide an affordable alternative for health care for animals, a new 12,000 square foot LEED-certified animal medical center is currently being planned. It will feature a state-of-the-art animal hospital and surgical facility on the ground floor and a training center on the second floor as an extended classroom

for students in Mt. SAC's and Cal Poly Pomona's veterinary technology programs. The center will also provide low-cost vaccinations, spaying, and neutering.


This addition will allow for the current clinic to be turned into a behavior enhancement facility to improve the sociability of challenging animals.
