

### PROGRAM - John Chase - District Governor

Both, John Chase and his wife Elizabeth, were born and raised in the Midwest. They relocated to Las Vegas in 1990, where Elizabeth worked in the airline industry and John became a police officer. In 2011, they opened Amerisent Insurance, an independent insurance brokerage office, in Boulder City.

John's most memorable Rotary Moments involved serving together with his daughters when they were 16: Ashley participated together with him in a polio vaccination campaign in India and Meghan went with him to Xpujil, Mexico, where they built water cisterns. Encouraging family involvement within Rotary is one of John's goals for his time as governor.

John asked us to consider expanding our support for the Rotary Foundation. This can be done in several ways: Rotary Direct allows for small, automatically deducted donations. Membership in the Paul Harris Society entails a monthly donation of \$85. And membership in the Bequest Society allows one to donate in a personal will, with the ability to specify in \$25,000 increments which causes will be supported. John also reminded us to share the joy and inspiration of being a part of Rotary by actively recruiting new members. To make this easier, we need to make sure that Rotary claims credit where credit is due, for example for Rotary's leading role in eradicating polio. Because if we don't proudly claim credit for our achievements, someone else will!
