PROGRAM - Dr. Daniel Wilson - WesternU

Western University of Health Sciences President Dr. Daniel Wilson shared the history of Western University of Health Sciences, from its start in an abandoned shopping mall to today.

The university first started as the College of Osteopathic Medicine, graduating its first class in 1992.

Four years later, Western University of Health Sciences was created.

The 1990s were busy with the opening of the Physician Assistant program, physical therapy program and the College of Pharmacy. The Colleges of Graduate Nursing and Veterinary Medicine opened in 1998.

In 2007, the Colleges of Dental Medicine, Optometry, Podiatric Medicine founded; and soon after, a \$100-million campus expansion project was launched. In 2009, the Colleges of Dental Medicine, Optometry, Podiatric Medicine welcomed their first classes. Not too far behind was the Graduate College of Biomedical Sciences which opened in 2010.
