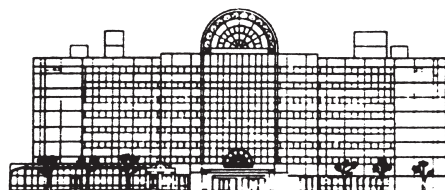

## PROGRAM - Jeff Johannson - Pomona Hope

Pomona Hope was founded 15 years ago when a group of recent local college graduates decided that they wanted to start a non-profit. When talking to many local politicians, organizations, and families, they found that the most pressing issues seemed to be lighting in the streets, neighborhood safety, and the availability of a safe after-school program for kids. They brought the first two issues to the attention of local authorities and law enforcement and decided to

focus their own efforts on setting up the after-school program: It begins with a healthy lunch and help with homework, after which students are offered guided one-on-one tutoring, performing and visual arts workshops (including field trips), technology workshops, leadership classes, college success classes, and physical education that teaches teamwork, sportsmanship, and nutrition. By heavily involving older students in the planning and running of the program (especially during intense summer live-in internships), Pomona Hope is not only able to function with just three full- and three part-time staff, but also provides a great learning experience for these students. Pomona Hope also offers programs and activities for parents, like a support group and Zumba, healthy eating, and gardening classes. The latter two make heavy use of the Center Street Community Garden that Pomona Hope created and helps to run. Unfortunately this garden is currently threatened by plans to develop the property and Pomona Hope is actively looking to save it by finding a new location for it. Pomona Hope's new strategic plan identifies the increase and clarification of parent involvement, the growth and utilization of partnerships, as well as the increase of funding as the main areas of focus.
