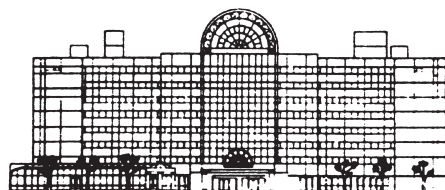

PROGRAM - Dr. Lee Stoltzfus

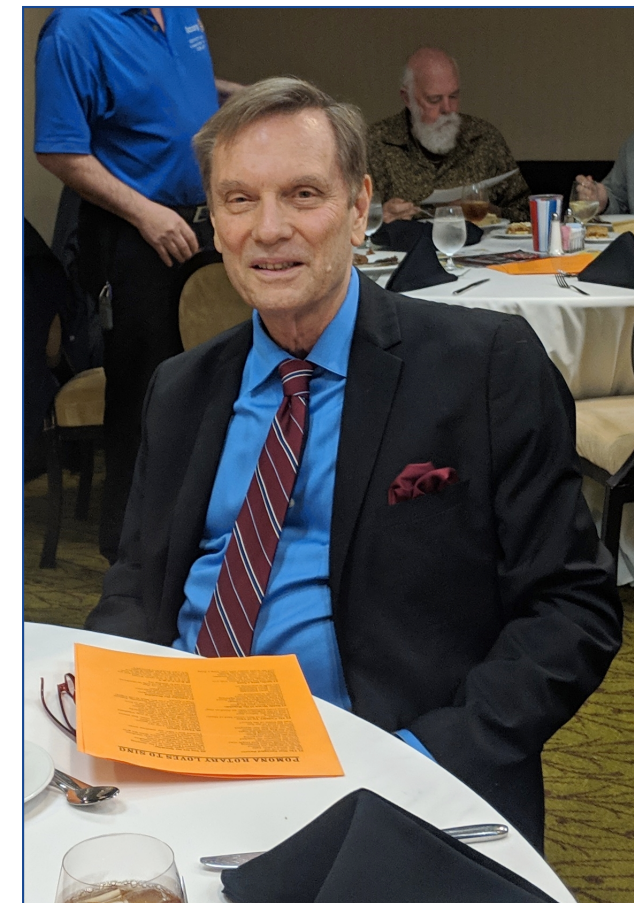
Dr. Lee Stoltzfus, a therapist and executive coach in leadership and organizational development, visited the club and shared some tips on how to create winning teams.
