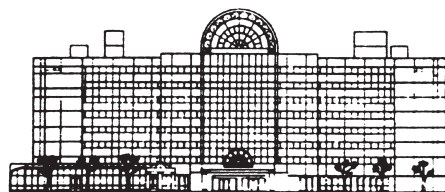

PROGRAM - Mike Olivieri - Pomona Police Dept.

The Chief started with PPD in 1990. He began his role as Police Chief in February 2018. He highlighted the following:

The importance of accountability and transparency to both the members of the department and the public. The department is doubling down on social media posts with the assistance of a PR specialist. The department website is being improved to give the public access to social media postings as well as making forms available online.

Staffing levels for Pomona PD are below national

averages. The national average is 1.6 officers per 1000 residents. Pomona PD is at 1.05 per 1000 residents. PPD is 85 officers below the national average.

Response times for life-threatening events are about four minutes.

The department has seven community service officers who will respond to non-life threatening events such as car break-ins etc.

The department has officers dedicated to do outreach for the homeless and has a Quality of Life detail. The department transports people wanted in other counties to those counties.

Four times the department has facilitated the purchase of bus tickets to reunite homeless people with their families after confirming that the families are open to the connection.

Of the 17 homicides in the city in 2018, 82% were solved.

Pomona PD officers are very proud that in 128,000 contacts, only 33 have involved use of force.

In nine years, the PPD has only had five deaths attributed to use of force.

Chief Olivieri entertained questions after the presentation.
