PROGRAM - J. Racadio - California sales tax

Jennifer Racadio of the California Board of Equalization visited the club to discuss recent changes to the department and its operations.

The Board of Equalization has added two new departments: the Department of Tax and Fee Administration and the Office of Tax Appeals. Many of the fees and permits used to operate a business can now be paid online at https://www.cdtfa.ca.gov/. Jennifer also spoke about how recreational marijuana is being addressed at the state level. She said there are between nine and 13 agencies involved in regulating recreational marijuana.

The department issues the following marijuana-related licenses: a cultivation license, manufacturer license, and distribution (retail) license. The excise tax is 15 percent on marijuana and marijuana products; however, the cost of marijuana is also affected by city and sales taxes, which vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction. Becoming a retailer also is dependent on the city in which the business will operate.

Because the business deals primarily in cash and there has yet to be a bank established to handle these funds, the state is starting to create ways to audit marijuanarelated businesses.


Jennifer said the department
