PETER PAN made an appearance at our rotary meeting this week. Captain Hook stole the show though, as a group San Marino High thespians gave us preview of their upcoming show. Peter Pan tickets are available now at San Marino High School. Box Office Hours: noon to 3:30 daily. Performances at 7:00 pm on Jan 30th and 31st. A special showing is on Feb 1 at 4:00pm. JOY FLORES talk this week concentrated on ways that people can reach out and help fight homelessness in Los Angeles. LA County has more than 60,000 homeless, which is the most in the nation. Joy spoke about proximity and getting close to the issue. We cannot ignore the people who are homeless but instead look for ways to volunteer. Over 3,000 meals are served each day at the Union Rescue Mission (URM) not to be confused with the Union Station. Joy talked about her life work and said it has been a calling. She said, God doesn't just look to call on the qualified, but he qualifies the called. Joy works every day on skid row, trying to help in a myriad of ways. When asked what programs work, Joy said, Program that are consistent and organizations that work in tandem with URM. She went on to say that many people that find themselves homeless do have family but struggle with a way to reconnect and repair relationships.

Pepperdine University partners to provide Mental Health Services, and **Schools on Wheels** consistently works in concert with URM to educate young and old, who find themselves on the streets. Joy said the URM will continue to provide soup, soap, and salvation to people on the streets, and she welcomes all San Marino Rotarians to volunteer their time.
