Dennis shared that in the nine-year period that the fundraiser has amounted to \$780,588. When asked by Bill Payne where monies should be allocated, Aaron was not shy to say that he would like to see the funds reinvested in the community. Arron said, I like brick and mortar projects that are sustainable. Aaron believes that this year s fundraiser will go to support continuing improvements to the Barth Athletics Facility, and separately to the Rose Arbor Project in Lacy Park.
