### **Shoddy Shares- International Project News:**

- Readers program 200 Spanish books at a cost of \$500 will be delivered by Franz to Avila Camacho Elementary School in Tijuana in May. Denise has 5 boxes of books available.
- Fund raising Laura Reinhart has provided a painting by Nieto Anton at a market price of \$1,500 to be used for fund raising for international projects. Denise will help at an art show auction in Fall 2019.
- Argentina farm equipment project project value increased from \$47,500 to \$57,679 with funding from 2 additional International Clubs in the Philadelphia area. SMR contribution is \$7,850. Project proceeding well.
- Cambodia Fish Tanks project project for \$3,500 to Community First approved and check sent. HMS Interact Club contributed \$1,000 to this water project. Await completion report.
- Cambodia Coconut Plantation project project to fund water supply, fencing and planting coconut trees approved at \$2,375, and check sent to ODA.
- Uganda School Water Collection and furniture project project for \$7,945 approved and check issued.
- Tijuana School Modernization project RC Tijuana Independencia s

- now online. Hopefully D5300 matching funds will be available in July 2019. We will consult with Franz before submitting proposal to SMR board, D5300 and RI for approval.
- Bicycles for Armenia Sebouh Bazikian of One Bicycle Foundation gave a
  presentation of his non-profit organization, and the bicycle program in
  Africa and other parts of the world. He will provide more information as
  to his activities in Armenia including the possibility of working on a
  global grant project.
- Reverse grant the PreK program is by Families Forward in Pasadena. Have consulted with RI whether such a project (\$40K) will be approved for a global grant. Will consult with D5300 whether matching grants could be available for the 2019/20 Rotary year. If the input is positive, then will write up a draft proposal and approach Rotary Clubs in Taiwan and Tijuana to be International Clubs for this project. May also approach Pasadena Rotary if more funds are required. Need budget of \$3K from board.
- Budget for 2018/9 since D5300 has no matching funds for this year, the budget of \$16,000 has been used for non-global grant projects, such as Corazon House Build, Cambodia Fish Tanks, Cambodia Coconut Plantation and Uganda School Water Collection projects. Mead fund is needed as a reserve. Donation of \$1,000 received from Fred Sohl.
- Budget for 2019/20 will request a budget of \$16,000 from board to be used for Tijuana global grant project, Corazon House Build and other projects such as Cambodia Aquaponics and Uganda school.
- Charlie Mead Fund the fund has been reduced by the Charities board by \$3,500 to about \$4,333.61.
- San Marino Rotary website � will be updated from time to time.
- Committee for 2019/20 ◆ JPM will be Chair of International Service.
   Proposed Co-Chairs for International Projects are SC, SJ and AK.
   Committee now at 19 members.
- Next meetings the next International Projects committee meetings will be held on June 27 and July 25 and Aug. 29 at 1.30 pm. The dates will not conflict with SMR board meetings. Stephanie has invited everyone to a cocktail party on 6/9 at 4 pm at her home to welcome Franz & Laura Reinert.
