He began experimenting with various other recipes that didn't quite fit into the well-established menu at Spike's. He left Spike's in 1998 and with the help and urging of good friends Ken Yankowski, Richie Quach, Sachiko Takeout and his mother, he opened B-Man's Teriyaki & Burgers in 1999.
