POLIO WALK information from Denise Wadsworth: Our Socially-Distances World Polio Day Walk is 4-6 PM on Saturday, Oct. 24, 2020. Our San Marino Club is also inviting our neighboring Clubs to join us. DK NEWS ABOUT BILLING & DUES: Due to the COVID-19 situation, there are further billing changes this quarter; for example, quarterly dues have been reduced down to \$47 (from \$120 normally and from \$95 last quarter). This change has been communicated previously in a letter from President Gil.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS from JP Mainguy:

Tijuana, Mexico (RI Global Grant GG1984610): Donated \$8,400 for the Jaime Sabines Junior High School Modernization project to improve the facilities of the school.

Soeng Sang, Thailand (RI Global Grant GG2011605): Donated \$5,250 for medical equipment for the Soeng Sang rural hospital: 2 patient monitors, 9 infusion pumps, and 1 pulse oximeter to a 60 bed hospital that serves 70,000 people in South Eastern Thailand.

Siem Reap, Cambodia: Donated \$15,000 to support ODA school teaching of English for disadvantaged communities in remote villages in the Siem Reap area.

Sen Sok, Cambodia: Donated \$3,700 to support Community First project to provide seed, fish fingerling and training to farm families in the Sen Sok area. Purchase a small motorcycle for Community First trainers to reach village families.

Tecate, Mexico: the committee is investigating the possibility of cooperating with Corazon and the South Pasadena Rotary club to build a family home near Tecate, Mexico
