## The San Marino Rotary Rotoscope for September 19th, 2019 By Russ Osmonson.

**Next week Pasadena Community College President, Dr. Erika Endrijonas will speak at the San Marino Rotary.** Prior to her service at L.A. Valley College, Endrijonas was executive vice president and accreditation liaison officer at Oxnard College and dean of educational programs at Santa Barbara City College. Statewide, she has served on the California Community College boards of the Chief Instructional Officers and Chief Student Services Officers associations and the Association for Occupational Education. She is also a board member of the California Community College Athletic Association and co-chairs the board of the national association LGBTQ Presidents in Higher Education.

**Bill Payne introduced the Tim Sloan to Rotarians this week.** Tim reminded Mitch Lehman that Tim attended The University of Michigan before beginning his remarks. Tim then began his talk and shared five leadership lessons:

- Run towards challenges. When you do this it creates excitement and also provides you with immediate responsibility.
- Take on roles that terrify you. This will create what Tim called ♦Vertical Learning.♦ You will learn at a fast pace.
- Stand up for what you believe. This experience provides a sense of confidence that will propel to accomplish even greater feats.
- Take responsibility when you are wrong. Shoulder the blame for mistakes and people will grow to trust you. Tim added that it a difficult task and that said that ♦Success has many parents, but failure is like an unnamed orphan, that no one wants.♦ Learn to shoulder responsibility.
- Know your vision, goals and values and read them often. Then read them again!

Tim had time for a few question from Rotarians. He answered questions about block chain and Cryptocurrency, saying they should not be confused as they are mutually exclusive. When asked if he believed in one or the other, it was clear that Tim felt that block chain will impact the future and improve communication. As for Cryptocurrency, Tim felt less secure. Tim also spoke about his feeling about the March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019 hearing, when he testified on Capitol Hill. In essence, Tim explained that he had to be measured with his responses to Congress as some of the questions during the testimony were, let♦s say confused. Tim explained that being at the hearing was highly unusual; answering questions in a normal fashion was not what one would expect. When Tim testified it seems that he did not get the opportunity to be as candid as he would have liked to have been. While at Rotary, Tim did not address the culture that existed, while he was at Wells Fargo, nor did he address any specifics about recent news related to Wells Fargo.
