**Speaker: Wolf Arnold- Craft Talk**

Wolf was born in Yugoslavia in 1939 just as WWII was beginning. His father served in the Hungarian Army, but he and his family had to move around due to bombing from the allied forces. In 1951 the family immigrated to the United States through a program for displaced persons. They came over on a troop transport and found out their sponsor had already taken in another family. If they could not find a sponsor they would have to go back to Europe.Wolf's father knew of someone in Detroit that had immigrated earlier and he was able to sponsor them. So Wolf grew up in Detroit later attending the University of Detroit and receiving a degree in mechanical engineering. He ultimately worked for GE and spent many years working in their jet engine division in various cities-Cincinnati(where he met his wife), Phoenix,Oklahoma and Ontario. He managed to attend Claremont College and achieved a Masters Degree in Business Economics. Ultimately, he left GE and opened a metal fabrication business.

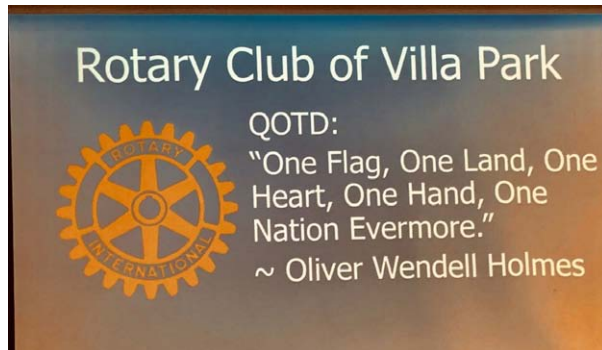
