the board of a number of Orange County crime and homelessness related boards. He has served in the Sheriff's Department for 31 years and was elected sheriff in the last election. He informed us that the OC Sheriff's Dept. is the 5th largest in the nation and has a navy and airforce. The sheriff adressed the human trafficking in Orange County which he described as prolific and talked about a task force that is designed to treat those involved as victims rather than prostitutes. He also spoke about the homeless situation, stating many of the homeless are drug addicts. Other items of discussion were the opioid epidemic which arises from the south and spreads throughout the country, the Search and Rescue Team that is all volunteer, the canine corps that has dogs that sniff drugs, bombs or cadavers. The fentanyl issue has also become a big problem...in 2017 the Sheriff's Dept seized 4 pound; 2018 more than 40 lbs which is enough to overdose the entire county 3x over. Sheriff Barnes is asking the judges to give the addicts longer sentences so he can detox them and get them into rehabilitation programs. His goal is to reduce the demand to reduce supplies. He has 100-120 inmates detoxing in jail as we speak. He lastly touched on the marijuana situation and the difficulties trying to prosecute drivers who are under the influence.
