He has served as the Engineer-in-Charge for several projects involving improvements to central heating and cooling systems, primarily on Northeast college and university campuses. He is the former Air Quality Practice Leader of Ramboll ♦ Southwest operations. He has over 35 years of experience in energy systems engineering, air quality management, permitting including CEQA, greenhouse gas (GHG) management, regulatory compliance, litigation support, expert witness work, risk management and pollution control engineering. Specific projects have ranged from Title V permit evaluations to managing the installation and start-up of multi-million-dollar air pollution control systems. His service on the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Advisory Council for nearly five years has provided him with an excellent understanding of regulatory processes. He uses this information to negotiate complex technical agreements and permits with agencies, assist facilities with compliance programs and provide technical expertise to litigation teams. Joe teaches air quality permitting and air pollution control courses at the University of California-Los Angeles. He also serves on the American Association of Port Autrorities Environment Committee. Joe is a past Board Member and chair of the West Coast Section of the Air & Waste Management Association, past Chairman of FuturePorts, and a past member of the CleanTech Orange County Board of Directors. Joe is also a Board Member of the Los Angeles County Business Federation and member of the BizFed SCAQMD/CARB Coalition. Joe recently joined the Board of EXP Future, which focuses on programs to help schools deliver innovative, career-based curricula.
