Reimagining Police Training in the 21st Century

Randy Shrewsberry, Executive Director Institute for Criminal Justice Training Reform

Randy Shrewsberry is a former police officer, having served in Ohio, South Carolina, and Indiana for more than a decade. Starting his career in criminal justice as a Police Dispatcher, he's held a variety of roles throughout his law enforcement career such as patrol, patrol supervision, training, investigations, crime prevention, inter-agency intelligence, warrants, community corrections, court services, and was contracted by the United States Marshal's Office. He's testified hundreds of times, including admission as an expert in several areas. Randy was named Police Officer of the Year in 1995 by the South Carolina Rotary Club.

After nearly 15 years in public service, Mr. Shrewsberry worked in the private sector as a Certified Fire and Explosion Investigator, Automobile Crash Reconstruction Investigator, Crash Data Recorder Analyst and most recently, as the Director of Forensic Services investigating both criminal and civil matters

In 2017, Randy founded the Institute for Criminal Justice Training Reform – the nation's only nonprofit advocacy organization that examines police training and education to promote sensible criminal justice reform. As the Institute's Executive Director, Randy has spoken publicly hundreds of times regarding police training - including with media organizations such as the New York Times, The Washington Post, MSNBC, USA Today and more.

This past Wednesday Frank Newell, Nel Varenas, and Laura Knapp reinforced the impact Long Beach Rotarians have in our community with an update on the Reading By 9 committee.

At our November 3, 2021 meeting, Frank held his annual fundraiser for Reading By 9. The result was a record \$86,500 raised with over 100 Rotarians and guests pledging contributions—and as Frank noted 100% of those pledges coming through with the money.

How were your contributions spent?

- \$10,000 to purchase almost 5,000 books for Kindergarten through 3rd grade students at 10 LBUSD Title 1 schools.
- \$10,000 to purchase almost 2,000 books for Pre-School children including over 100 "I Love You Rituals" books for teachers in Early Childhood Development Program. This book provides activities and lessons to help improve children's literacy, attention span, and discipline in the classroom.
- \$3,000 "Best of" series grants to 3 LBUSD Elementary schools.
- \$3,000 to support the AOC7 Literacy Fair.
- \$1,500 to purchase books for the 2022 LBUSD Kindergarten Festivals.
- \$1,500 provided books, educational supplies, and some expenses for the recent Mark Bixby Easter Egg Hunt and Paul Kennard Book Fair event.
- \$20,000 for 12 Literacy Awards to Non-Profit organizations.
- \$20,000 for Literacy Awards to 22 Pre-School and Elementary school teachers.
