Hear Josie M. share her story of living on the streets of Long Beach and her journey to find housing stability and employment. A chance encounter with "Duke" Givens, local community activist, changed both of their lives and paths.

Care Closet LBC was founded by **Sylvester �Duke� Givens**, a graduate of Long Beach Poly High School, is a Long Beach native who grew up in the 6th district. He joined the U. S. Air Force during the Desert Storm conflict and was honorably discharged. Upon returning home, Duke enrolled in Long Beach City College; he majored in photography which would become a staple in Duke�s life. His body of work has been showcased in different venues and has received a multitude of acknowledgments and awards. Most recently, he was recognized by the Long Beach City College Foundation for induction into the Hall of Fame. His passion for helping the most vulnerable, led him to create the non-profit, Care Closet LBC.
