Randy Shrewsberry is a former police officer, having served in Ohio, South Carolina, and Indiana for more than a decade. Starting his career in criminal justice as a police dispatcher, he so held a variety of roles throughout his law enforcement career such as patrol, patrol supervision, training, investigations, crime prevention, inter-agency intelligence, warrants, community corrections, court services, and was contracted by the United States Marshales Office. He stetified hundreds of times, including admission as an expert in several areas. Randy was named Police Officer of the Year in 1995 by Rotary in South Carolina.

After nearly 15 years in public service, Mr. Shrewsberry worked in the private sector as a Certified Fire and Explosion Investigator, Automobile Crash Reconstruction Investigator, Crash Data Recorder Analyst and most recently, as the Director of Forensic Services investigating both criminal and civil matters.

In 2017, Randy founded the Institute for Criminal Justice Training Reform • the nation• sonly nonprofit advocacy organization that examines police training and education to promote sensible criminal justice reform. As the Institute• Executive Director, Randy has spoken publicly hundreds of times regarding police training - including with media organizations such as the New York Times, The Washington Post, MSNBC, USA Today and more.
