Mayor Richardson is a regional leader, having served as the President of the Southern California Association of Governments—the largest metropolitan planning organization in America.

Since taking office, Mayor Richardson has led with his Opportunity Beach Agenda—the first 100-day plan ever presented by a Mayor of Long Beach. Your YS Team is putting those pieces together to create strong Interact (high-school) and Rotaract (college & community) clubs that build young community leaders and act as conduits to all that Rotary has to offer.

Our over-arching goal over the next two years is to have an Interact Club at each of the 11 high-schools in LBUSD, Rotaract Programs at the 2 colleges, and a community Rotaract. We have 10 of our 14 liaisons in place and are looking for four more people to help build clubs and attend one meeting per month. Other roles include planning youth volunteer opportunities, and general hands-on-deck.
