Expanding Park Space

Brent DennisDirector of Parks, Recreation and Marine

Brent Dennis was appointed as the Director of Parks, Recreation and Marine in July of 2020. Mr. Dennis brings over 40 years of experience in various complex park departments in city and county governments as well as non-profit agencies in the Midwest and California.

Mr. Dennis served as the Director for the City of Tucson's Parks and Recreation Department where he led the department through its first successful voter-approved bond ballot initiative known as Proposition 407 that now provides \$225 million of funding and reinvestment in 100 different city parks. During his time with the City of Tucson, Mr. Dennis oversaw the successful launch of many key initiatives such as a new Park Ranger Program and a transformative, non-toxic integrated Weed Management Program.

Mr. Dennis also served as Director of Community Services for the City of Anaheim, Assistant Director of Operations for the Golden Gate Park, Director of San Francisco Botanical Garden and Director of Conservatory of Flowers at San Francisco Recreation and Parks Department.

The Parks, Recreation and Marine Department has an annual budget of \$74 million and has a team of nearly 700 staff during summer season peak programming. Programming occurs within the City's 166 parks, 27 community centers, 3 pool facilities, 5 golf courses, 6 miles of beaches and 3 marinas. Professionally as a landscape architect with a keen eye on quality design, high maintenance standards and a commitment to community engagement, under Mr. Dennis' leadership, Long Beach parks and recreational facilities will be safe, clean and welcoming to all. That's his promise!

Invitation - Celebrate San Pedro Rotary 100th, a Club the RCLB sponsored in 1922!


The Rotary Club of San Pedro is indebted to the support of the Rotary Club of Long Beach.
