Geraldine Knatz is Professor of the Practice of Policy and Engineering, a joint appointment between the University of Southern California's School of Public Policy and the School of Engineering. She served as the first female Director of the Port of Los Angeles from 2006 to January 2014 and prior to that was Managing Director at the Port of Long Beach. Knatz made a significant impact on the maritime industry through the creation and implementation of the San Pedro Bay Ports Clean Air Action Plan. In 2014, she was named a member of the National Academy of Engineering in recognition of her international leadership in the development of environmentally clean urban seaports. That same year she was honored with Containerization & Intermodal Institute's Lifetime Achievement Award. She is past president of the American Association of Port Authorities and past president of the International Association of Ports and Harbors. An author of several books about Los Angeles Harbor, Knatz's career has been featured in several popular books, most notably in Pulitzer Prize winning journalist Edward Humes's *Door to Door*, David Helvarg's *The Golden Shore* and Bill Sharpsteen's *The Docks."*
