**Carolyn Caldwell** is currently the President and CEO of St. Mary Medical Center (Dignity Health) in Long Beach, California. St. Mary's Hospital is a 389-bed academic facility with a Level II Trauma Center that offers extensive health care services to the greater Long Beach Community. Carolyn is a Healthcare Executive with over 30 years' experience in the healthcare industry.

Carolyn has excelled through the ranks in several executive positions. After spending over twelve years on the clinical side of the healthcare industry, Carolyn was promoted to Chief Operating Officer at Dallas Southwest Medical Center (HCA). Shortly after becoming C.O.O., she was named Interim C.E.O. and coordinated the sale of the Hospital to a physician group. Subsequently, Carolyn was promoted to Chief Operating Officer of a larger facility, Medical Center of Arlington (HCA) a 326-bed facility in Arlington, Texas. During her tenure with the Medical Center of Arlington, Carolyn oversaw a \$70 million construction project which included a three story Women's Center. After spending 3 1/2 years with Medical Center of Arlington, Carolyn was promoted to Chief Executive Officer at Lee's Summit Medical Center (HCA) in Lee's Summit, Missouri, and tasked with building an \$85 million replacement facility. Carolyn was instrumental in achieving a major turnaround in service, quality and satisfaction at Lee's Summit Medical Center during her tenure. Two months after opening Lee's Summit Medical Center, Carolyn was once again promoted to lead Centerpoint Medical Center (HCA). Centerpoint Medical Center flourished in several areas under Carolyn's leadership.

In 2012, Carolyn became the Chief Executive Officer of Desert Regional Medical Center (Tenet) in Palm Springs, California. Desert Regional Medical Center is a 385-bed tertiary academic medical center. During her tenure at Desert Regional Medical Center she oversaw the creation of five medical residency programs, exceeded EBTIDA by 15% compared to budget and 38 % compared by prior year during the first two-years. She also established the only comprehensive stroke center in the region.

She is a Fellow with the American College of Healthcare Executives, member on the California Hospital Association Board of Trustees, ACHE Governor, and Board Member on the Long Beach Chamber of Commerce. Carolyn is a past member of the AHA Region 6 Policy Board and Past Chair of the AHA

Institute for Diversity for Health Management. Carolyn is a former Board Member of the American Hospital Association (AHA). Carolyn served as the President of the Palm Springs Chamber of Commerce during the 2016-2017 FY.

Carolyn has led highly functioning corporate teams which have exceeded EBITDA performance, demonstrated growth in various service lines and achieved positive results in overall engagement.
