Duke Givens is a Long Beach native, who grew up in the Sixth District of Long Beach, CA. He received his education in the Long Beach Unified School District and graduated from Long Beach Poly High School. He also served in the United States Air Force during the Desert Storm conflict and was honorably discharged.

Soon after being discharged, he attended Long Beach City College to study photography. Photography would become a staple in Duke's life. He has created a body of work that has been showcased in different venues and received a multitude of acknowledgements and awards. Some of these recognitions include the NAACP Community Service Award, the United States Congress for Community Efforts, the African American Men's Forum President's Award, and most recently inducted into the Long Beach City College Hall of Fame.

His passion for helping the most vulnerable among us led him to create the Non-profit Care Closet LBC. The Care Closet LBC's is the commitment to meet the needs of our unhoused brothers and sisters.

International Service

The RCLB's International Avenue of Service strives to support people who live in areas of the world which lack the basic resources necessary for life. Primarily, we:

1. Support New Water Wells in Mozambique. Through Rotary International's Global Grant Process and support from Rotary Clubs all over Southern California, we partner with the Rotary Club of Polona, Moz. and Water Underground to improve the lives of the people of Mozambique by placement of water wells in villages which lack access to clean water. Through donations of just \$10,000 through RCLB, we expect to raise \$150,000 for 5 wells in 5 villages in 2024.

2. Support of the Navajo. The RCLB Navajo Project aims to create Rotarian to Navajo relationships with the

This project includes raising money within our Club and from other Rotary Clubs here and in Arizona for water projects. We are planning our third trip to the Navajo nation in the Spring 2024, which will include a work party to help make basic repairs to community buildings located there.

3. Mexico. The RCLB has for years traveled to Caborca, Mexico with Clubs in our District. We have interacted with the Rotary Club of Caborca and administered the Polio vaccine to help stop the spread of Polio. This year we are evaluating other potential projects for Mexico which will help support the RCLB's mission.

We are currently seeking funding from our Long Beach Rotary Charitable Foundation for the Mozambique and Navajo Projects. If you would like to support these projects, please reach out. We need both volunteer support and financial support to make these projects a success.


