Hollywood s Variety magazine calls her the lady who turned entertainment coverage into big biz. Rona Barrett is a pioneering entertainment reporter, commentator and producer with a career spanning more than 30 years. Now, as a nonprofit pioneer, she is the Founder & CEO of the Rona Barrett Foundation the catalyst behind the Golden Inn & Village, affordable housing and wellness services campus for low income seniors.

Her career began at the age of 13 when she conceived and organized the first international fan club. Her earlier efforts helped launch the careers of Eddie Fisher and Steve Lawrence. From the time she became an entertainment columnist for the Bell-McClure newspaper syndicate as the youngest columnist to ever report on Hollywood in 1957 and through her role in inaugurating Good Morning, America, Rona has blazed the trail for innovative entertainment reporting and for women in the media industry.

Don Cochran is someone who takes his Rotary volunteer role seriously. He is a regular Wednesday attendee, a fervent supporter of our youth programs including Camp Enterprise and Interact Clubs, and is a tireless advocate of our scholarship program. Service Above Self in spades.

Following the death of his wife, Maria, he decided to put his money where his passion was. He established the *Cochran Family Scholarship*. This scholarship serves students from the North or West side of Long Beach, specifically in the 90805 or 90810 zip code, who will be attending Long Beach City College. This scholarship will remain with the recipient throughout their undergraduate education as long as they maintain their grades and full-time enrollment. The student will receive \$1,500 each year while they are attending LBCC, and, should they choose to transfer to Cal State Long Beach, then the amount will increase to \$2,500 per year. Finally, the student must demonstrate overcoming a personal hardship, engage in community service and have an inspiring story.
