Dr. Don Schwartz received a Ph.D. in European Diplomatic History from New York University. He has taught at Pace University and The New School for Social Research in New York City before joining the history faculty at California State University Long Beach in 1987. In addition to his teaching responsibilities, he served as the Social Science Credentials Coordinator, training students for careers as history teachers.

At Cal State Long Beach Dr. Schwartz taught courses on World Wars I and II, the Holocaust, and The Cold War, and has published numerous articles on those subjects. He has been named by The Organization of American Historians as an Outstanding Lecturer in History.

After his retirement in 2010 he taught in Shanghai and Phnom Penh as part of the Fulbright Specialist Program. He continues to offer lectures on historical topics to the general community in Long Beach and Orange County at CSULB OLLI and via Zoom.
