This Week's Meeting

Desertarian Report: Jim Dunn

Janet Haas discussed the DG in her district who is skydiving with club members as a fundraiser for polio eradication.

Guest Speaker: Geoff Kors, Mayor, City of Palm Springs Mayor Kors reported that COVID hospitalizations are down in the valley. County numbers are declining also which is positive progress toward reopening more widely. Kors noted that most businesses have worked cooperatively to adhere to restrictions.

The City was facing a projected \$25 million shortfall. It appears that sales tax is coming in better than projected. 80 City staff positions were eliminated along with all capital projects with the exception of the downtown park. The park will continue already initiated construction. Expected completion is spring of 2021.

The Mayor also noted that Palm Springs is getting a relatively small amount of COVID financial assistance from the State. He explained that the greatest amount of funds will go to larger cities as measured by number of residents. The top six cities will get \$175/resident, the next six will receive \$85/resident and the rest (under 300,000 residents) will get \$12/resident.

Restaurants will be allowed to utilize parking spaces in front of their businesses. That will be happening soon.
