Dr. Victoria Bentley was our awesome speaker and she started her work in Africa in 2005 and continued till 2015. She shared the horrific conditions for women and children and the effects of the war. Congo is rich in much needed minerals that we need for our technology to survive on continues to be a battlefield. The woman fled to safety after repeated atrocities with rape as a continual war practice, Victoria was called to offer her services and after finding out their needs she came home and started fund raising.

While there, she started a factory with sewing machines to help the women start making money. She then with the help of her Rotary Club in Montecito CA sent 100 of kids to school and got them and their mothers medical assistant. At the same time Victoria helped start a Rotary Club there to help distribute the money she raised. The goal is to help these mothers and children. She then hooked up with Amani Matabaro and his charities. With the help of Rotary he built reservoirs giving them clean water. They also built schools, also provided the families with goats and taught them how to grow vegetables and provide food. Victoria's Rotary Club also brought supplies and materials to make dolls that they sold and it help them build a future.

Victoria shared a wonderful coping skill called tapping which helped them to release all the trauma. Victoria continued helping them create a bakery and a home for teen mothers previously abused to help them raise healthy children and learn a profession. She also helped build the community center and was so influential to start, manage and continue the center and it is still standing. They still need help with training for the woman and sanitation as well as programs to help these children once they graduate.

Helene suggested we talk to our governor about bringing a training group to the Congo.

Frank Peabody was one of our Vocational speakers and was an inspiration. Frank celebrated his 21st Rotary anniversary on the 15th!
