Indio, Coachella, and Cathedral City have the most cases, due to folks more unable to work from home, and living in closer conditions in multi-generational homes. More senior deaths occurred in PS, RM, and PD, due to an older population. Our number of cases peaked in June and have since decreased to the point we graduated to the 'Red Zone', allowing greater outdoor and social opportunities. Space doesn't allow for all Dr Les' latest stats. He recommends that we all continue to wash your hands, socially distance, and wear face coverings.
