Today's speaker was Dr Shubrah Kerkar, Medical Director, Desert Regional Medical Center. Since the vaccine was rushed to the market in record time, she addressed 'Winning your trust of two types of Covid-19 Vaccines. She shared a video of a question and answer session with an apprehensive RN. Among the RN's concerns were short- and long-term side effects, does the Vaccine contain virus particles, what if you are pregnant or with HIV? Dr Kerkar, also reviewed the history and success of past vaccines. The present vaccines require two injections within a 28-day period. There were questions regarding distribution and administration of the vaccine.

COVID-19 testing at our DHS RiteAid drive-through for free. Go to https://www.projectbaseline.com/

- 1. Click the COVID box
- Sign in with your email address. If you have insurance, enter the information. If you have Medicare, enter your Medicare number and your group number is "Medicare." (They will ask you for the Medicare Billing address: PO box 6774, Fargo ND 58108)
- 3. If you have no insurance, indicate that. The system will let you choose the next available date and time and will send you a verification which you take with you (show your cell phone or printed info. along with a picture ID.) They will put a swab in an envelope and pass it to you while in your car. You insert it in your nostrils (midway), then put the swab in the vial they give you and put it back into their tray. Off you go! They will let you know by email if you are negative or call you if positive.

It looks like they are accepting appointments for people over 65 too!
