
## November is Rotary International Foundation Month

We began with our speaker, Jennifer Richard from Voices for Children. They provide an additional volunteer, called a Casas, for children in Foster Care. Foster children receive support from a Judge for the legal issues, a Social Worker to assist with educational needs, and a person to assist with keeping the Foster child in touch with brothers and sisters.

The Casas is a volunteer advocate and problem solver, who coordinates with the other team members to ensure the Foster child's needs are met. The workload of the average Social Worker can be 35+ cases. The Judge deals with 135+ cases. The Casas offers a valuable one on one assistance to the Foster child to monitor their emotional needs, educational needs, and Foster Family requirements and regulations.

Casas' must be 18+ years old, be available for an 18-month period, and be a full-time resident of the Valley.
