### ***We have a very special speaker from Rotary International!***

Julia joined the Rotary Club of Amesbury, MA in 1997 and served as president of the club in 2001-02 and the club's Foundation Chair from 2016-2020. She has served in several positions at the district level including District 7930's Foundation Chair, leading the district through the Future Vision Pilot. She shared Future Vision insights at the New Orleans, Louisiana and Lisbon, Portugal International Conventions.

Julia has served as a President's Representative and the Rotary Foundation Alumni Chair (RFAC) for Zone 32. She served as International Director from 2014 - 2016 and in 2016 - 2017 was a member of the Operations Review Committee. Julia served as a member of RI's Membership Committee from 2017 - 2019.

In 2017, Julia was appointed as a Trustee of our Rotary Foundation and served until 2020. She was a member of The Foundation's Stewardship Committee three years and in 2019 - 2020 served as Chair. Julia was also a member of the Foundation's Executive Committee from 2018 - 2020. She served as the Trustee Liaison to the Leadership Development and Training Committee. Currently, Julia is the Vice-chair of the Basic Education and Literacy Major Gifts Committee (BEI-MGI) and is an active member of the Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene Rotarian Action Group (WASH). She serves on the Operation Team of the Action Group and has chaired the World Water Summit since 2017.

Julia is the recipient of the Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service and the Distinguished Service Award. She and her husband, Steve McKenzie, who is also a Rotarian are Majors Donors and charter members of the Bequest Society. She is a Paul Harris Society member. Julia is currently leading the Million Dollar Journey for the Rotary Foundation in District 7930.

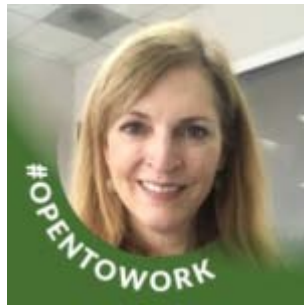
