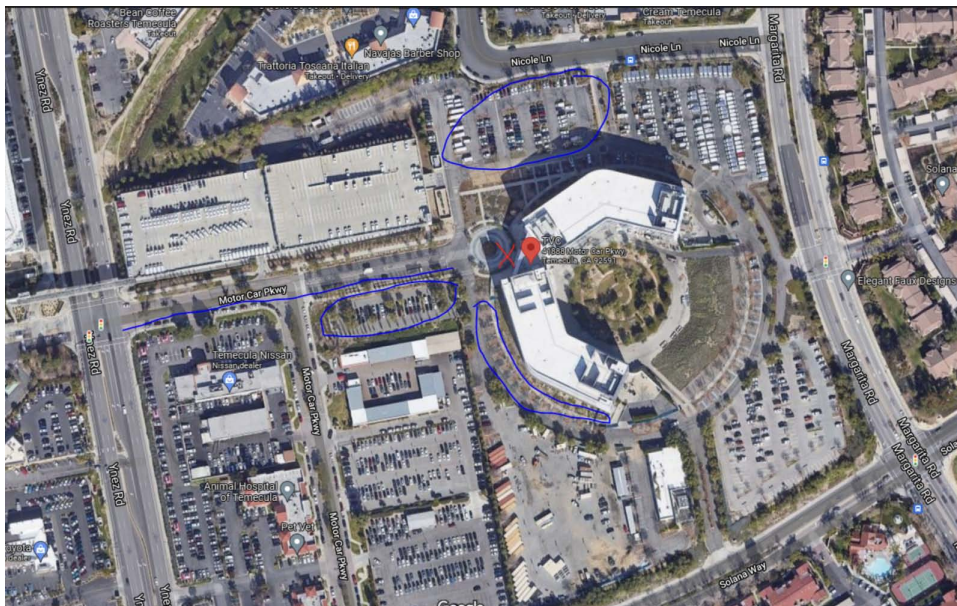
Please plan on arriving 10-15 minutes early so that you have time to park and locate the board room.
