President Message



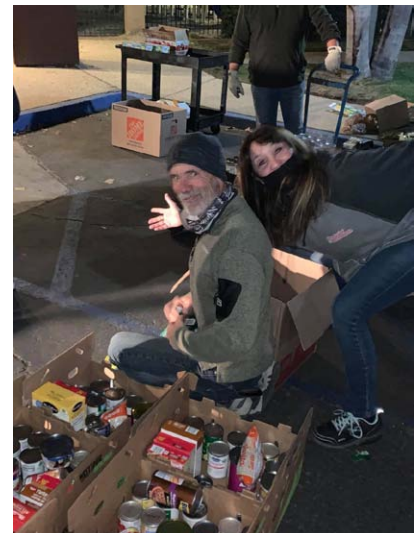

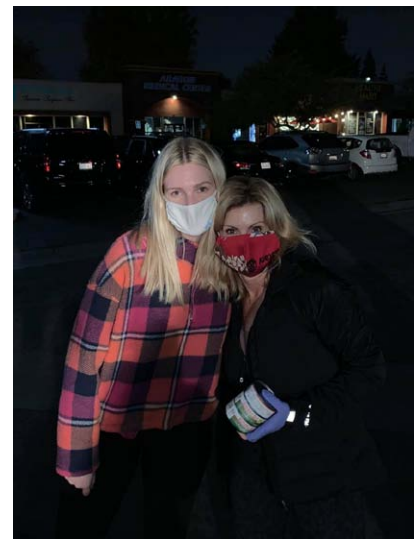
