Happily **Donna Buss** met Dr. Phil Bresnahn on an airplane last year and invited him to speak to our Club about his Smartfin. "What is a Smartfin?" you ask. A Smartfin is a surfboard fin; we used to call them "skeggs," designed to measure ocean health. The idea is for surfers and paddle boarders all over to attach the Smartfin to their boards and go surfing or paddling. The Smartfin transmits water temperature, location, and CO2 data automatically back to the Scripps Institute of Oceanography for analysis. One goal is to get as many water folks involved as possible, and they're working on products for boats and watercraft larger than surfboards. The more data the better for Dr. Bresnahn.
